

#### FROM THE PASTOR'S DESK

#### Advent 2024 & Jubilee Year

Greetings and well wishes for a good advent season as we prepare for Jesus Christ's coming at Christmas. We know He came that first Christmas 2024 years ago and He always comes in the sacraments and in the gathered church (God's People) and He will come again in the end-times. Let's watch for Him always.

We just ushered in the New Liturgical year. In 2022, the month of February, Pope Francis, the Holy Father, the Bishop of Rome, announced the year 2025 as a Jubilee year. The theme of the year is "Pilgrims of Hope", to promote peace in our world overtaken by wars, climate change and Covid-19. The pope said, in part, "We must fan the flame of hope that has been given us and help everyone to gain new strength and certainty by looking to the future with an open spirit, a trusting heart and far-sighted vision. The forthcoming Jubilee can contribute greatly to restoring a climate of hope and trust as a prelude to the renewal and rebirth that we urgently desire".

The Jubilee year will begin with the Mass at St. Peter's Basilica, on December 24, 2024, and the opening of the Holy Door of the Basilica. The Jubilee year ends December 23<sup>rd</sup>, 2025. A plenary Indulgence is granted to Jubilee pilgrims. There will be various opportunities and events at the Vatican and in local dioceses for "pilgrims of hope" to participate in December 26, Pope Francis will open the Holy Door at a Roman Prison in Rebibbia, Roma. Other doors to be opened include the Holy Doors of the Basilica of St. John Lateran (Rome's Cathedral), the Basilica of St. Mary Major, the Basilica of St. Paul outside the walls, among others. Outside of Rome, local ordinaries (Bishops) will designate basilicas, cathedrals, shrines and other sites as designated places of pilgrimage or places of prayer for the pilgrims of Hope in 2025.

In Rome, there will be the Jubilee of Young People in July – August of 2025. The Pope's jubilee prayer is below.

#### THE JUBILEE PRAYER

Father in Heaven,
May the *faith* you have given us
in your son, Jesus Christ, our brother,
and the flame of *charity* enkindled
in our hearts by the Holy Spirit,
reawaken in us the blessed *hope*for the coming of your Kingdom.
May your grace transform us
into tireless cultivators of the seeds of the Gospel.

May those seeds transform from within both humanity and the whole

cosmos

in the sure expectation
of a new heaven and a new earth,
when, with the powers of Evil vanquished,
your glory will shine eternally.
May the grace of the Jubilee
reawaken in us, Pilgrims of Hope,
a yearning for the treasures of heaven.
May that same grace spread
the joy and peace of our Redeemer
throughout the earth.
To you our God, eternally blessed,
be glory and praise for ever.

#### A message from Fr. Danny Cogut:

As many of you know, a couple weeks ago I was in the hospital for a couple days for anemia. It turns out that the reason for it was that they found cancer in my stomach, and possibly my liver. Obviously, this came as a great shock to me and my family—as I'm sure it does for you all. I plan on getting treatment in Richmond, to be with my parents. There are still lots of unknowns about the prognosis and treatment options, but I've asked Bishop Knestout for a medical leave of absence starting Monday, December 16. He has graciously offered to appoint a temporary priest-administrator of OLPH for the duration of my treatment, which may take several months. We don't know who that will be yet (as of the time of this writing), but hopefully it will be announced soon. God willing, I'll be able to return after the treatment. I know this will seem like déjà vu for many of you, with the illnesses of our previous pastors (as it does for me and my family, with my sister). I'll be asking for the intercession of our dear Servant of God Frank Parater (https://richmonddiocese.org/office/francis-j-prater/) for healing, and I humbly ask you all to do the same. Frank was a Richmond seminarian, a graduate of Benedictine, and an Eagle Scout, who died in Rome from rheumatic fever at the age of 22. "Remember, the Sacred Heart never fails those who love Him." - Frank Parater (1897-1920)




