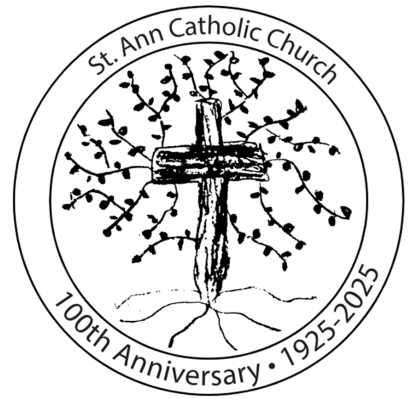
SAFE ENVIROMENT

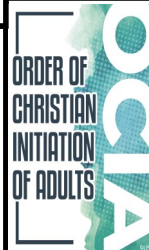

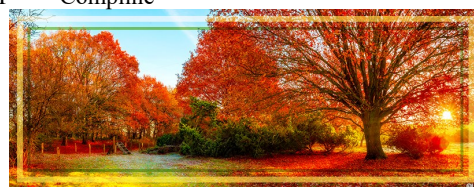
